Safety Log protocol and Record of Maintenance

Eye Wash & Shower Inspection Form

According to the American National Standard Institute's (ANSI) Emergency Eye Wash and Shower equipment standard Z358-1-2014, weekly flushing testing for proper operation on the eyewash and shower station must be performed and documented. Note that OSHA incorporated the ANSI standard with respect to eye wash and shower station inspection.

Procedure: **Weekly** flush the eye wash and shower stations to ensure it is working properly and is unobstructed and accessible. Document the inspection noting any deficiencies or problem. Contact: (INPUT the contact person information here name, title, phone number and email address), or the office of EH&S, HU to correct any problem.
